

General terms, advertising information

XiBIT takes the protection of your personal data seriously. We treat your personal data confidentially and in accordance with the legal data protection regulations as well as with this data protection statement.

Surfing on our website is usually possible without providing personal data. The indication of personal data (for example a registration or a web shop accessible to a registered user) is always, as far as possible, voluntary.

The user agrees that XiBIT stores its indicated and existing master and traffic data, as well as data resulting from business relations (e.g. administration, billing, data protection, support, market research, studies, services, for the improvement of services in the automated process and for the improvement of services at all), uses and evaluates it, and to utilize the results thereof (e.g. publish, make available to others).

The registered user also agrees that XiBIT may use the same data to send information about products and services as well as special and advertising campaigns to them, by mail, e-mail, fax, telephone or SMS. Consent may be revoked at any time by the customer by e-mail to office@xibit.at or by postal transmission sent to the address specified in the imprint. XiBIT is also entitled to store and use protocols of the IP addresses within legal provisions. Saved data is adequately protected by XiBIT according to the respective state of the art.

XiBIT is not liable for illegal interventions by third parties (e.g. viruses, hack attacks). XiBIT may use third parties in its services and in the processing of the data, while respecting the relevant provisions of data protection. Users acknowledge that their provided data can be viewed by third persons.

The registered user expressly agrees and resigns the assertion of any requirements e.g. because of infringement of private policy, that data which he provides is stored and can be forwarded to governmental bodies (police, courts, customs authorities, protective association against unfair competition or other institutions, as well as the Austrian advertising council), who inquire concerning contents, which are published and spread via XiBIT and could be against the law. This also includes activities in the area of private electronic communications.

Furthermore, the user agrees to transfer the data to those other third parties whose rights are infringed by the dissemination of content or the unlawful activities set by the customer via XiBIT, or who alleges a violation in a comprehensible manner. This applies in particular in the case of the transfer of data to third parties in the course of a request for information, e.g. §18 (4) ECG.

We would like to point out that data transmission on the Internet (for example, when communicating via e-mail) can have security gaps. A complete protection from the access of data by third parties is not possible.

SSL encryption
